Dear Priests, Parishes, Parish Life Directors, Deacons, and Catholic Pastoral Centre Staff:

Generally at this time of the year, an announcement regarding clergy appointments and transfers will have taken place, with the moves generally effective at the end of July. While there will be some transfers, this year we are faced with continuing impacts of the pandemic on the government immigration processing centers leaving the arrival of international clergy, five of whom have been invited, entirely unknown.

Given this situation, the transfer of existing clergy to new assignments will also have to be delayed until such time as we have an indication of replacements. Please keep the priests awaiting the immigration process in your prayers.

Having said this, I am pleased to announce the arrival and appointment of Rev. Kenneth Webb, FSSP, as the Moderator and Chaplain of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Latin Mass Community (SHJLMC) – a Public Association of Christ's Faithful in the Diocese of Saskatoon, effective June 1st. Fr. Webb has just arrived in Saskatoon and will be living at a residence-rectory within several blocks of St. Joseph's Parish in Saskatoon, where the SHJLMC has an agreement to celebrate the Mass according to the 1962 *Missale Romanum* (extra-ordinary form of the Latin Rite Mass) on a regular basis.

Fr. Webb has visited our diocese on several occasions in support of the SHJLMC during the previous Christmas and Holy Week/ Easter season. I am pleased to welcome Fr. Webb to our diocese, and to our clergy fraternity here. I also wish to express my appreciation to Rev. Darryl Millette, who has served as Moderator and Chaplain until Rev. Webb's appointment.
