**Financial goal:** For over 25 years, the Sacred Heart of Jesus Latin Mass group has had the goal of having our own F. S. S. P. priest, our own church and a full parish life. In order to reach this goal, the Diocese of Saskatoon wants to see our weekly collection reach a minimum of \$1,550 per week or \$80,000 per year. This would support a priest and a church without a mortgage. Last Sunday's collection: \$1,908.05.

**Meeting with Bishop Hagemoen:** Although the Latin Mass committee does not have a lot to report, we wanted to let you know that we met with Bishop Hagemoen on February 27<sup>th</sup>. We gave him our annual report and financial statement for 2019. He was pleased with the report on the activities of the community, and he commented on our good financial standing. The bishop is supportive of our goals of bringing the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter into Saskatoon and having our own church, so that we can have a full parish life. He is working to help us meet our goals. Please pray that we may have a good outcome soon.
