Here below is a quick overview of the parameters of the said committees:

- A Finance Committee: the Chaplain-Moderator administrates the temporal and spiritual goods of a Catholic Parish or Association. Canon Law specifies that a Finance Committee (of 2 or more lay members) assist the Chaplain-Moderator in the administration of the finances. Technically this is the only Committee 'required' by Canon Law. Practically, it is best that if there is a Pastoral Council (which is merely consultive), the Finance Committee operates separately from it as deliberative body. Members must be a Confirmed Catholic, practising their faith, and in good standing with the Church;
- The Pastoral Council: a Chaplain-Moderator may choose to form a consultive committee with representation from various lay members of the parish or community. There is no specific numeric limit to membership. Members may serve provided they are a Confirmed Catholic, practising their faith, and in good standing with the Church. This body helps discern the vision, activities, and needs of the Community. Helping the Chaplain-Moderator in a consultative role to plan for and carry out the mission of the Church whose chief purpose and law is ordered towards the salvation of souls. This can range from coordination of catechetics, evangelization and faith formation, charitable works, community life etc.;
- Building-Capital Sub-Committee: under the direction of the Chaplain-Moderator and his Finance Committee, this ad hoc committee will be formed to help discern and plan for the prospects of fundraising for, building/purchasing, and developing the future home of our Community. Proposals will be made back to the SHJLMC and to the Bishop after the preliminary work is done. I will look to secure from the Bishop an approval for a Capital Building Campaign once these committees are formed. The said campaign will allow us to direct giving towards our future home.
- Fundraising Committee: under the direction of the Chaplain-Moderator and his Finance Committee, will oversee the fundraising appeal for the Community and its future approved Capital Campaign;
- Social-Community Life Sub-Committee: under the direction of the Consultative-Pastoral Council, will help to plan various social and community activities for the edification of the Community.
