**Financial goal:** For over 25 years, the Sacred Heart of Jesus Latin Mass group has had the goal of having our own F. S. S. P. priest, our own church and a full parish life. In order to reach this goal, the Diocese of Saskatoon wants to see our weekly collection reach a minimum of \$1,550 per week or \$80,000 per year. This would support a priest and a church without a mortgage. Last Sunday's collection: \$2,256.15.

**Medically assisted suicide and euthanasia:** Monday, January 27<sup>th</sup> is the deadline to respond to a government survey on limits to medically assisted suicide and euthanasia in Canada. Canadians are being consulted in light of a recent court ruling that eliminates "reasonably foreseeable death" from the eligibility requirements for medically assisted suicide and euthanasia. Safeguards are needed to protect the lives of the most vulnerable and to stop the expansion of assisted suicide and euthanasia.
