For those interested in walking from Duck Lake to the shrine, we meet at Duck Lake interpretive Centre parking lot at 11:15 am to begin walking at 11:30am. Please note that the hike is 13 kms (about 3 hours) and at a fast pace, which may be difficult for small children and anyone who is not used to walking long distances. We will walk together as a group, so it is important to be on time and stick together as we walk. Duck Lake is an hour drive from the church, so be sure to bring your change of clothes to the church and lunch to eat in the car. Transportation will not be provided, but we can help you find a ride with someone if need be. All minors should be accompanied by an adult.
